Thursday Novem 21st 1867

Commenced

with light westerly winds

got most of our crew onboard

at 3 Pm took Pilot and Log

and went out side lay off

and on through the night

So Ends

Friday Novem 22nd 1867

Begins and ends

with light airs from the

East and S.E. at 3 Pm Capt

Winslow and three mate came

onboard and steered to the

South themselves not on board

So Ends

Saturday Novem 23rd 1867

Begins and ends

with light airs from the East

land in sight Steered Chances

and Anchors Chose look crews

and watches and steered E.S.E.

So Ends

Sunday Novem 24th 1867

Commenced

with light winds from E.S.E.

Ship steering S.E.E.

So Ends
