Sunday Dec 1st 1867
Commences with

Strong Trade Ship heading
Lat 12.31 S S.E. Middle and last
Long 154.31 points the same So Ends

Monday Dec 2^d 1867
These 24 hours

Begins the same as the last
at 11 Am wore ship to the
North to avoid an Island layed
down on the Chart at 3 Pm
Lat 10.54 wore to the E S.E. at
daylight made all sail
So Ends

Tuesday Dec 3^d 1867

Begins with
Strong trade winds well
to the East Ship heading
S.S.E. last part wind
Lat 9.17 S.S.E. Ship heading E and
E by N with much rain
saw one sail
So Ends

Wednesday Dec 4th 1867
Commences.

with light winds from
the S.S.E. with much
rain ship heading to the
E by the wind shifted
to the Middle and last
part wind E N.E. with
heavy rain
So Ends

Bound South 1867

Thursday Dec 5th 1867
Begins with

a strong breeze from E.N.E.
Ship steering S.E. with
hard rain Middle and
Lat 6.29 last part fine weather
Long 151.20 wind N.E. Ship steering
S.E. So Ends the day

Friday Dec 6th 1867

Commences
and continues with good
weather wind N.E. Ship
steering S.E. under all
sail saw a school of small
blackfish Middle part
Lat 4.22 the same last part
wind S.E. with much
rain So Ends

Saturday Dec 7th 1867

Begins
with wind from S.E.
Ship heading S.S.W. imployed
repairing the Dolphin
striker at 6 Pm got
through Middle part the
Lat 2.02 saw at 10 Am saw a
Long 152.00 brack proved to be a
fouback imployed mending
the foresail
So Ends
