so ends

Friday Dec 13th 1867

Begins and
continues with a fresh breeze from
the E, N, E, ship heading S, E,
Lat 6.27 } employed repairing and painting
the boats Middle and last
parts the same
so ends

Saturday Dec 14th 1867

These 24 hours
begins the same as the last
Lat 9.48 } last part the same
so ends
