Sunday Dec 15th 1867
Commenced

with a fresh breeze from
Lat 9.48 E. N. E. Ship heading S. E.
Long 149.41 at 10. Am tacked to the North
at 2 Am tacked to the S. E.
Squalls of rain
So Ends

Monday Dec 16th 1867
Begins with

Squalls of wind and rain
from the East Middle and
Lat 11.00 last parts the same as the
South first employed repairing
the boats So Ends

Tuesday Dec 17th 1867
Commenced

with fresh squalls of wind
and rain from N. E. and
East Ship heading from
Lat 12.02 S. E. to E. S. E. employed
Long 149.13 on the Boats Middle and
last parts the same
So Ends

Wednesday Dec 18th 1867
Begins with

a good breeze from E. Ship
Lat 14.27 heading S. S. E. employed
Long 149.15 repairing boats
Middle and last parts
the same employed
painting boats
So Ends

Thursday Dec 19th 1867
Commenced

with a fresh breeze from
the East Ship heading
S. S. E. employed painting
the Bow Boat at 5 Am tacked
to the N. E. employed on the
boats So Ends

Friday Dec 20th 1867

Begins and
Ends with variable winds
Ship heading to the N.
Lat 13.21 N. E. at 7 Am tacked to
Long 147.58 the S. E. took in Starboard
boat to repair
So Ends

Saturday Dec 21st 1867

These 24 hours
begins with light East
winds with much rain
Middle and last parts
the same So Ends

Sunday Dec 22^d 1867

These 24 hours the
same as the last
So Ends
