a light breeze from N.W.
Ship steering E by N
Middle and last parts
baffling winds employed setting
up rigging So Ends

Tuesday Dec 24th 1867
Commences
the same as the last 24 hours
the last part a light
breeze from N.W. Ship
steering E by N employed
setting up rigging
So Ends

Wednesday Dec 25th 1867
Begins with
a light breeze from the
N.W. Ship steering E by N
at 2 P.M. saw Blackfish
Long 146.09 lowered all four Boats
the B.B. struck and got
a large one
Last part the wind light
and puffing with calms
So Ends

Thursday Dec 26th
Begins with
light airs and calms with
much Rain at 5 P.M.
a good breeze from the
N.W.

Lamelane Bound East

At 6 P.M. commenced boiling
our Blackfish at 11 P.M. got
through So Ends

Friday Dec 27th 1867
Begins with a
good breeze and fine weather
from N.W. Ship steering
E by N at 1 P.M. saw Black
fish lowered without success
Middle and last parts
the same So Ends

Saturday Dec 28th 1867
These 24 hours
commences the same as the
last at 3 P.M. saw Disappointment
Islands bearing S E $\frac{1}{2}$ S dist
Lat 14.00 about 20 miles Ship steering
Long 140.24 E by N under all sail
Middle and last part the
same So Ends

Sunday Dec 29th 1867
Commences with
a light air from East Ship
heading S. S. E. at 5 P.M. more
to the N.W. employed in
ships duty
Middle and last parts
the same So Ends
