So Ends

with light baffling winds
and much Rain
Middle part the same
So Ends

Saturday ~~Friday~~ Jan 4th 1868
Begins with
a strong wind from the
N E with much Rain
and hard squalls split
Main top Gallant Sails and
at 2 Pm Mizzen top Stay sail double
Set 11.42 reefed the Top Sails furlled
Long 138.50 gibb and Main Sails
Middle and last part
much Rain
So Ends

Sunday Jan 5th 1868
Begins with
a fresh breeze from N E Ship
heading N N W employed
repairing sails
Middle and last parts
fine weather at 5 Pm saw
the Island of Madelena one
of the Marquesas So Ends
