Sperm Oil at 5 PM got
through
At 6 PM commenced stowing
down So Ends

Wednesday Jan 22nd 1868
Begins with strong

trade employed stowing
down at 4 PM got through
Middle and last part
very squally much rain
So Ends

Thursday Jan 23^d 1868
These 24 hours

begins with strong winds from
E, N, E with squall of rain
Middle and last parts
the same
So Ends

Friday Jan 24th 1868
Begins and
ends with strong trades
So Ends

Saturday Jan 25th 1868
Commences with
strong trades saw nothing
Middle and last parts
the same So Ends

Sunday Jan 26th 1868
These 24 hours
strong winds with frequent
squalls of rain
So Ends

Monday Jan 27th 1868
These 24 hours
the same as the last
So Ends

Tuesday Jan 28th 1868
Begins and Ends
with strong trades with rain
employed setting up and
repairing Casks
So Ends

Stowed down
2416 Gallons
Sperm Oil
Jan 28th
