last part same
So Ends

Saturday Feb 8th 1868

Commenced more
moderate at 5 PM Gained
with Bark Aruashanks
Middle and last parts
fine weather
So Ends

Sunday Feb 9th 1868

Strong breeze
from N.N.E. Ship on
different tack saw nothing
So Ends

Monday Feb 10th 1868

These 24 hours
the same as the last
saw nothing but the
land So Ends

Tuesday Feb 11th 1868

Begins and
ends with fine weather
and sail in light
So Ends

Wednesday Feb 12th 1868

Commenced and
continues with fine weather
one sail and the Island in
light Middle and last
parts the same So Ends

Thursday Feb 13th 1868

Begins and ends
with fine weather impleyed
fitting New Mast Coats
Middle and last parts
the same So Ends

Friday Feb 14th 1868

These 24 hours the
same as the last
So Ends

Saturday Feb 15th 1868

Commenced and
continues with good weather
at 4 PM spoke and gained
with Bark Aruashanks at
6 1/2 PM shortened sail while
Reefing fore Top sail Manuel
Laines Boatstern fell from
the starboard yard arm struck
the anchor killing instantly
and from the anchor overboard
a boat was lowered but he
sunk to rise no more

Feb 15th 1868

lost overboard
