a light breeze from N.E.
ship heading East by the wind
Middle and last parts
the same so ends

Commences
with a light breeze from
the N.E. Island bearing North
Middle and last parts
Calm so ends

Saturday Feb 22nd 1868

Here 24 hours
calms and rain squalls
employed hooping the tank
so ends

Sunday Feb 23rd 1868

Begins and
ends with calms and rain
so ends

Monday Feb 24th 1868

Begins with
wind S.E. at 6^{1/2} PM
raised sperm whale & lowered
whales going quick to land
the Bow boat struck and
lost her whale by the breaking
of the fore the mast
boat struck and got stove
a heavy squall came up lost
the run of the whales
ends with heavy rain
and wind
