So Ends

Wednesday Febr 26th 1868
Commences with
baffling winds ship working
in to the land 3 PM came
too Anchor in thirty fathoms
of water
So Ends

Thursday Febr 27th 1868
Begins and
Ends with fine weather
all hands employed getting
off water and stowing down
So Ends

Friday Febr 28th 1868
These 24 hours
the same as the last employed
getting off water and other
ships duty
So Ends

Yamela at Anchor in Madelon

Saturday Febr 29th 1868
Begins and ends with
strong Trades all hands employed
getting wood and water and
stowing down
So Ends

Sunday March 1st 1868
These 24 hours
fine weather all but three men
on liberty
So Ends

Monday March 2^d 1868
Begins and ends
strong winds with squalls
of rain two boats off draining
at 5 PM got back with small
success Bark Ceriale dragged to
sea sent men to help get
up her Anchor
So Ends

Tuesday March 3^d 1868
These 24 hours
the same as the last all hands
employed getting wood and
water
So Ends

Wednesday March 4th 1868
This day the
same as the last
So Ends
