Thursday March 5th 1868
Begins and ends
with good weather one match
on shore So Ends

Friday March 6th 1868
Thes 24 hours
all hands two boats off
hauling the net getting Wood
at 11 PM the boats got back
loaded with Boggs Potatoes
and Lefruit So Ends

Saturday March 7th 1868
Begins and
ends with strong trades
at 12 PM got under way and
went to sea
So Ends

Sunday March 8th 1868
Commences
and Ends with good
weather saw one sail to
windward
So Ends

Monday March 9th 1868
Thes 24 hours the
same as the last
So Ends

Samuelson at Sea

Tuesday March 10th 1868
Begins and ends
with good weather light
winds at 10 AM started
to the West saw nothing
So Ends

Wednesday March 11th 1868
Begins with
light winds from E-
N-E ship steering to
the N. N. W. saw one sail
So Ends

Thursday March 12th 1868
Begins with
light winds good weather
at 2 PM spoke a schooner
last part fresh breeze at
6 1/2 PM saw sperm whales
lanced the B. B. struck
line parted
So Ends

Friday March 13th 1868
Begins with a
fresh breeze ship working
to windward at 2 PM
saw the whales to wind
ward lanced but could not
strike last part good
weather saw nothing
So Ends
