Lat 3.26 Ship steering N by Compass
Long 142.55 watch employed overhaling
West Cutting Gear
So ends

Friday March 20th 1868
These 24 hours strong
winds ship steering N. N. W.
So ends

Saturday March 21st 1868
Begins and ends
with squally weather steering
N. W. by N under all sail
So ends

Sunday March 22nd 1868
Lat 4.44 These 24 hours the
same as the last
So ends

Monday March 23rd 1868
Begins with strong
winds with squalls of rain
at 5 P.M. Main Top sail split
sent it down and hoist with
the last part. the same
So ends
