

Bound to Sandwich Islands

Tuesday March 24th 1868

Begins and ends
Lat 11.28 with a fresh breeze from
E. S. E. ship steering N. W. by W.
under all sail
do ends

Wednesday March 25th 1868

These 24 hours
Lat 13.16 the same as the last same rain
Long 146.25 do ends

Thursday March 26th 1868

Begins with
good weather ship steering N. W. by W.
ends with a strong wind
splitting fore top sail
do ends

Friday March 27th 1868

Begins and
ends with fresh trades
do ends
Lat 17.51
Long 143.44

Saturday March 28th 1868

Commenced with
a fresh breeze from E. S. E.
at 6 PM took in main
sail and doubled reefed
ship steering N. W. by W.
at daylight saw the
Island of Hawaii 20 miles
dist made sail and
steered down the South
side do ends

Homelane off the Sandwich I.

Sunday March 29th 1868

Begins with a good
breeze ship running along
the land at 17 PM ship
off Point Pili one sail in
sight Middle part Calm
East part a good breeze
from the S. W. at 11 PM
took Pilot at 11 1/2 fathoms
in Hawaii Bay in 10 fathoms
of water do ends

Monday March 30th 1868

Begins with
fine weather employed
mashing ship do ends

Tuesday March 31st 1868

Begins and
ends with fine weather
all hands employed Bunting
ships Bends getting of
Recruits do ends
