Bay. Calm through the
night last part light
airs and Calms ship in
the Delamores

Begins Cabin at
3 1/2 Pm took strong trades
and started for Honolulu
at 10 Pm off Honolulu

Friday April 3^d 1868

Begins with
good weather at 12 Pm
Capt Winslow went on
Shoar at 5 Pm boat come
on board

Middle and last parts
good weather at 8 Pm
boat on Shoar

Bound to Kodiak

Saturday April 4th 1868

Begins with
strong winds and last part
hard squalls ship laying off
and on a Capt Winslow
on Shoar

So Ends

Sunday April 5th 1868

Commences
with strong trades at 2 Pm
sent on shoar Stewards and
second mate things discharged
steward and second mate
Also sent the Chest and
bedding and cloths belonging
to Manuel Lewis Baalstine
Drowned February 15th
Middle and last parts
fine weather

So Ends

Monday April 6th 1868

Begins and
ends with fine weather at
9 Pm sent boat on shoar
