Begins and
ends with light variable
winds and fog
So Ends

Wednesday April 29th 1868

Begins with a
light breeze from S. S. E.
Ship steering N. W. by W.
Middle and last parts the
same So Ends

Thursday April 30th 1868

Begins with
a light west wind ship
steering N. N. W. bent near
by John Bay Sylva went
off duty with the vessel
Middle and last parts the same
So Ends

Begins with light
west winds Middle part calm
last part wind S. W. ship
steering N. W. W.
So Ends

Saturday May 2nd 1868

Commences with
a fresh breeze from the West
with fog squalls ship steering
N. W. under all sail
Middle and last parts same
So Ends

Sunday May 3rd 1868

Begins with
a strong breeze from S. W. ship
steering N. W. Middle and last
parts thick fog and rain
Sent down Fore Top Galant yard
So Ends

Monday May 4th 1868

Commences with
a strong breeze from W. S. W. ship
steering N. W. by N. squalls of snow
Middle and last parts the same
So Ends

Tuesday May 5th 1868

Begins with
strong winds from the West ship
by the wind heading N. N. W.
under double reef Middle and last
parts the same
So Ends
