Thursday May 14th 1868

Begins calm at 4 Pm light breeze from the East found one of the Main Top Galant Shrouds parted sent up a new one bent new Main Top stay sail Middle and last part wind East with fog

So Ends

Friday May 15th 1868

Begins with wind from the East with fog at 5 Pm same squalls though the fog proved to be Wright whales got aboard of the ship at 6 lit up a little lowered three boats without success whales going quick to windward Middle and last part fine weather same nothing

So Ends

Saturday May 16th 1868

Begins with wind East with rain and snow at 5 Pm same and whales to windward to reach to lower Middle part rain and snow last part strong squalls

Sunday May 17th 1868

Begins and

continues with strong winds from S.W. at 6 Pm saw two Whales Com and Calf at 8 Pm lowered three boats the S.B. struck and sank the Com very rough

Monday May 18th 1868

These 24 hours begins the same as the last employed coiling lines saw a merchant bark Middle part strong Gale from S.E. ship under storm sail last part wind West and moderate

So Ends

Tuesday May 19th 1868

Begins with wind from S.E. ship steering S.W. bent fore top sail last part the same

So Ends

Wednesday May 20th 1868

First part wind S.W. middle part strong Gale from S.E. ship under storm sail last part wind S.W. ship steering S.E. by E under short sail
