 Begins with
 wind S W with fog steering
 N E by E under short sail
 Middle and last ports same
 so ends

Friday May 22nd 1868
 These 24 hours
 Begins and ends with wind
 and fog from South Ship
 steering N W by N under
 short sail so ends

Saturday May 23rd 1868
 First part
 wind N W Ship by the wind
 Lat 56.18 with fog and rain middle
 Long 143-04 part same last part wind
 West Ship steering N W by
 N under all sail

Sunday May 24th 1868
 Begins and ends
 with fine weather Ship steering
 to the N N W, under all
 sail so ends

Monday May 25th 1868
 These 24 hours
 the same as the last
 so ends

Tuesday May 26th 1868
 Begins with good
 weather wind W S W Ship
 Lat 58.30 Steering N E by E under
 Long 139.40 all sail at 2 PM saw a
 whale, lowered all four boats
 the W B struck the whale
 run to windward both boats
 broke got to the ship at 8 PM
 took in sail Middle part
 wind N E, with hard rain
 last part wind North and clear
 saw the land of Mt Gorney
 so ends

Wednesday May 27th 1868
 Commences with
 a light breeze from N W Ship
 under all sail land in sight
 Lat 58.50 yesterday saw 4 whales
 Long 139-20 Middle and last part light
 air from N E land in sight
 so ends

Thursday May 28th 1868
 Begins with
 a light breeze from N E Ship
 steering S W, under all sail
 Middle and last part calm
 employed mending sails
 so ends
