Monday June 8th 1868

 ends with good wetter saw
 ship sail spoke ship Shihmay
 boiling her fourth whale
 last part imployed
 standing down
 so ends

 Foresters Island and ~~Queen~~
 Charlottes & sail one boiling
 and one cutting saw no
 whales last part steered
 to the North and West
 so ends

Wednesday June 10th 1868
 Begins with a
 strong breeze from the S.E.
 saw whales lowered without
 success saw seven sail and
 quite a number of whales
 so ends

Thursday June 11th 1868
 Begins with a
 strong breeze from S.E. ship
 under short sail saw several
 whales too rough to lower middle
 part rain last part fine wetter
 saw a whale lowered the S Boat
 missed the whale broke the
 Boat steered it being the third
 whale lost through him
 his name Manuel King took in
 his place Henry Kanaker
 so ends
