land lowered this boat
no go so ends

Saturday June 13th 1868

Begins and ends
with strong south wind
saw nothing so ends

Sunday June 14th 1868

These 24 hours
the same as the last
so ends

Monday June 15th 1868

These 24 hours
the same as the last
so ends

Tuesday June 16th 1868

Begins and
ends with light south
wind spoke Bark Cein
clean so ends

Wednesday June 17th 1868

Begins and ends
calm one sail in light
so ends

Thursday June 18th 1868

Begins and ends
with light air and calms
so ends

Friday June 19th 1868

First part
light breeze from the East
at 1 P.M. spoke and landed
with Bark Cein Capt Ceinos
90 sperm 125 whale this season
at 2 P.M. saw whales landed
without success last part
calm and fog
so ends

Saturday June 20th 1868

Begins and ends with
a breeze from the N.W. which
fog cleared to the E.
so ends
