Sunday June 21st 1868
Begins and Ends
with light air and calms
saw nothing so Ends

Monday June 22nd 1868
This 24 hours the
same as the last at 10 Am
saw Whales lowered all four
Boats at 11.45 Am Burn Boat
so Ends

Tuesday June 23rd 1868
Begins with Boat
fast and light breeze from
N.W. at 1 Pm Whale turned
up and sunk heavy lapped
him at about 20 fathoms all
the boats fast after about
5 hours got him up it being
very rough run one line to
the ship parted the line the
starboard boats logger head
broke the other boats could not
hold the Whale and had
to cut and lost the whale
last part fresh breeze from
N.W. spoke ship S.C. and
Bark Lanny
so Ends

Heavy fog in night
Bark Lanny N.W.

Wednesday June 24th 1868
Begins with
wind from N.W. at 8 Pm
Gained with Bark Holman Capt
Snider nothing this season
last part wind S.E.
so Ends

Thursday June 25th 1868
Begins with
a fresh breeze from S.E. 4 sail
and the land in sight
at 6 1/2 Pm Gained with Bark
Alto Capt White 2 Whales.
Middle and last parts served
to the W.N.W.
so Ends

Friday June 26th 1868
Begins with a
light breeze from the East
Stagg Island in sight at 6 Pm
about Calm
Middle and last part same
so Ends

Saturday June 27th 1868
Begins with
a light breeze from the S.E.
Ship Steady to the W.N.W.
with fog last part Calm
so Ends
