 Begins with
 a light breeze from N.W.
 Lat 56.30 Ship on different tack
 working to the North along
 the land last part Calm
 So Ends

Monday June 29th
 Begins and
 ends with wind N.W.
 thick most of the time
 at 5 P.M. Tamed with back
 going ship working to the
 N and west
 So Ends

Tuesday June 30th 1868
 These 24 hours
 the same as the last
 So Ends

Wednesday July 1st 1868
 Commences with
 wind West thick and overcast
 ship still beating to windward
 Middle and last part Calm
 So Ends

Thursday July 2^d 1868
 Begins and Ends
 Lat 58.2 with light baffling winds
 Long 138.30 and fog land not sight
 at times
 So Ends

Friday July 3^d 1868
 Begins and ends
 with wind from N.W.
 with fog ship working
 to the west
 So Ends

Saturday July 4th 1868
 These 24 hours
 wind S.E. ship steering
 W by S under all sail
 So Ends

Sunday July 5th 1868
 First part
 wind S.E. with rain
 middle and last parts
 wind S with rain
 So Ends

Monday July 6th 1868
 Begins with
 wind West with fog and
 squalls of rain ends the
 same
 So Ends

Tuesday July 7th 1868
 Begins with
 a light breeze from N.E.
 Lat 58.26 ship steering S.E. with
 Long 137.10 rain Middle part Calm
 last part wind N.E.
 ship steering S.E.
 So Ends
