Wednesday July 8th 1868

57 Ship steering S, S, E. under
all sail the first part wind
Lat 57.49 S. W. ship heading S S E
Long 148.17 by the wind at 5 Pm saw
weight whale going. Failed
to mindward lowered
without success ship on
different tacks
So Ends

Thursday July 9th 1868

Begins with
fine clear weather wind
at W ship by the wind on
an different tacks
Middle and last parts
the same
So Ends

Friday July 10th 1868

Begins with
wind S. W. ship heading
to S S E. Middle part
same at 8 Pm rain and
south gale sent parted
took it in splendid and
set it up So Ends

Saturday July 11th 1868

First part
wind S W Middle part same
last part wind E. ship
steering S S W under all
sail with rain So Ends

Shaidak

Sunday July 12th 1868

Commences
with a strong Gale from N E
Ship steering S W by S. took
Mainsail and late sails
at 3 Pm took in Fore Top sail
and fore sail Close Reefed
Main Top sail and have too
wind N W blowing hard with
rain Middle part Clear
So Ends

Monday July 13th 1868

Begins and ends
Lat 54 58 with a strong breeze from
Long 153 12 S W So Ends

Tuesday July 14th 1868

These 24 hours
a strong Gale from S W
Lat 55.7 last part blowing hard
Ship under Storm sail
So Ends

Wednesday July 15th 1868

Begins with
a strong Gale from S W
Middle part more moderate
last part wind S W ship
under all sail heading
S W Middle and last
parts rain
So Ends
