Friday July 24th

57 Begins with a fresh breeze from the S at 2 PM ship passed between Okanok and Tilgia Islands at 4 PM through into Bristol Bay ship showing N.W.W. by compass at 4 PM Steered North at 10 AM saw several Whales to rough to lower So Ends

Saturday July 25th 1868

57 Begins with a fresh Gale from S.W. Ship under storm sail last port Modderate saw plenty Whales lowered L.B. struck whole run like mad lost line and Purses Gun Bag &c So Ends

Sunday July 26th 1868

57 Begins with Wind N.W. boats got to the ship Middle port fog last port light airs and Calms Saw Whales lowered all 4 Boats at 11 1/2 PM L.B. struck So Ends

Monday July 27th 1868

57 Begins Calm Boat fast and towing the Whales to ship at 6 PM got along side got ready-

and Commenced Cutting at 10 1/2 PM got through last port fog laid and clear wind N.W. saw one sail to windward Whaling So Ends

Tuesday July 28th 1868

57 Begins with wind N.W. with squalls of fog and rain saw two Whales to windward at 7 PM Commenced Boiling saw nothing So Ends

Wednesday July 29th 1868

Begins with wind S.W. employed boiling some fog saw two sail one Whaling Middle port fog last port rain. Cooled down So ends

Thursday July 30th 1868

Begins with wind S a fresh Gale with rain saw several Whales to rough to lower Middle port the same last port more moderate at 7 PM started the macks So Ends
