Saturday August 8th 1868
Begins with clear
good weather at 4 PM saw a Whale
lowered all the boats the W.B.
struck and got the Whale at
2 PM got him to the ship
at daylight commenced cutting
2 PM got through saw plenty
Humpbacks So Ends

Begins with
a fresh breeze from S.W. at 2 PM
commenced hauling ship
under short sail middle
part strong winds and rain
So Ends
