Last part much rain at 6 Am
Cooled down So Ends

Monday August 10th 1868

Commences with
a strong breeze from W. S. W.
with much rain Ship under
storm sail Middle part
the same at 5 Am thick fog
but no rain wind N. W. E.
started the fire at 8 Steered
to the S. S. W.

So Ends

Tuesday August 11th 1868

Begins with
a fresh breeze from the North
Ship steering to the S. S. W.
at 3 Pm Clear Employed boiling
Middle and last parts the same
So Ends

Wednesday August 12th 1868

the 24 hours
the same as the last saw plenty
fin and shrimps Employed
boiling at 8 Pm got through
So Ends

Thursday August 13th 1868

Begins and ends
with wind from the South
at 6 Am in playe stowing
down Oil
So Ends

Bristol Bay

Friday August 14th 1868

Begins with
wind from S. W. with fog
Employed stowing down at 8 Pm
got through Middle part
Clear last part the same
So Ends

Saturday August 15th 1868

Begins calm the
Lamp in sight and one sail
St. Pauls bearing S. W. by S.
dist about 45 miles Middle
part light breeze from N. E.
last part fresh breeze from same
point two sail in sight
at 7 Am steered to the W. S. W.
at noon shortened sail luffed
too heading W. S. W. wind N.
So Ends

Sunday August 16th 1868

Begins with a fresh
wind from the N. Ship heading
W. S. W. under short sail
at 6 Am steered to East at
11 Am saw St. Pauls spoke and
Garnet with Bark Alto
So Ends

Monday August 17th 1868

First part fog
Middle part same last part
Clear same down sail
So Ends
