Tuesday August 18th 1868

Begins with a light breeze from the S at 1 Pm saw a whale lowered the boats whale going to windward showing no chance to strike at 2 Pm thick fog at 4 Pm Landed with 1000 lbs to Middle and lost parts fog

Wednesday August 19th

Begins with wind S thick fog Middle and lost parts same So Ends

Thursday August 20th 1868

Begins with wind S W. the Island of St George in sight at 10 Pm Landed with Ship Rainbow and Steered to the N W E in company So Ends

Friday August 21st 1868

Begins with wind from S W Ship Steering N E Rainbow in company at 8 Pm luffed too at daylight Steered to the N E, So Ends

Bristol Bay

Saturday August 22nd 1868

Begins with wind South Ship Steering N E at 8 Pm Shortland sail luffed too thick fog and rain Middle and lost part wind S S E at daylight water light Green at 9 Pm got a sound in 20 fathoms Steered N W, So Ends

Sunday August 23rd

Begins with wind S S E Ship Steering W S W, thick fog at 4 Pm Strong breeze the fog Middle part same last part light breeze with rain Ship laying aback water light Green 22 fathoms plenty Codfish east 70 So Ends

Monday August 24th 1868

Begins Calm with fog and rain at 1 Pm wind S W strong more ship heading Lat 59.15 W. S. W. under all sail at 10. Long 167.51 Pm wind S W with rain and fog more to the W N W blowing fresh Ship under storm sail So Ends

Tuesday August 25th 1868

Begins with a fresh breeze from S W Ship heading W N W under double reef
