Lat 48.59 Middle and last port same
Long 168.16 Saw several Timbals
So Ends

Thursday August 26th 1868
Commences with

fine clear weather wind N.
at 2 PM saw a whale lower
all four boats at 3 PM S. E.
struck the whale run to
leeward ship and 3 boats
in chase at 8 PM whale
turned up thick and hard
rain boats 8 miles to leeward
at 11 PM saw the ship light
at 12¹² midnight whale along
side raining hard at 5 PM
commenced cutting got one lip
and lashed down to rough
the cut So Ends

Friday August 27th 1868
Begins with

a fresh Gale from S E and E
with much rain whale along
side Middle part more
moderate at 4 PM fine
weather and light breeze at
5 PM commenced cutting at
8 PM Calm
So Ends

Bristol Bay

Saturday August 28th 1868

These 24 hours
Begins with fine weather
Lat 58.16 all hands employed cutting
Long 176.05 at 3 PM all through at 4 PM
started the work with fine
weather Middle and last ports
the same So Ends

Sunday August 29th 1868

Begins with
light baffling winds employed
boiling Middle part same
last port strong wind and
rain So Ends

Monday August 30th 1868

Begins with
a fresh gale from the N E
with rain at 4 PM cooled
down Middle part same
last port again strong
breeze at 7 PM employed
boiling So Ends

Tuesday August 31st 1868

Begins and with
a light breeze with squalls
of rain and snow
employed boiling
So Ends
