stowing down at 7 1/2 AM
the watch at 6 AM commenced
stowing down at 10 PM checked
off the Main Hatch
So Ends

Friday Sept 4th 1868
Begins and
continues with good weather
employed stowing down in
the after hatch at 8 got
through last part fine
weather steered to the
S.W. two sail in sight
So Ends

Saturday Sept 5th 1868
Begins with
a fine breeze from N.W. ship
steering to the S.W. St. George
and St. Pauls in sight
last part Calm Islands in sight
So Ends

Sunday Sept 6th 1868
Begins with
a light breeze from N.W.
Ship steering S.W. at 6 PM
spoke Schooner Tanager 4 sail
in sight Middle and last
part Calm

Monday Sept 7th 1868
Begins with a
fresh breeze from N.W. saw
nothing last part Calm
So Ends

Tuesday Sept 8th 1868
Begins with
a calm at 2 PM saw a
Whale lowered without success
Middle part Calm last part
a fine breeze at 8 PM saw
a Whale lowered the Whale saw
the boat at 10 lowered again
without success at
So Ends
