Wednesday Sept 9th 1868

Commences with
a strong breeze from the
East at 1 PM lowered for the
same whale no go at 2 1/2 PM
lowered again for the same
whale L.B. and W.B. boats the
L.B. struck whale jam and
sounded bad it blowing a
Gale Sep signal to Cut
at 5 got along side all
sail Cleared down Middle
and last parts a fresh Gale
So Ends

Thursday Sept 10th 1868

Begins with
wind fog and rain from
the East at 2 PM set fore
Topsail and fore sail
Middle and last parts a Gale
from the N.E. with fog and
rain So Ends

Friday Sept 11th 1868

Begins and Ends
with wind and fog from
N.E. ship under short sail
So Ends

Barstall Bay

Saturday Sept 12th 1868

Begins and ends
with a strong wind from
E.S.E. at 8 PM Gored
with Barks jany and George
Middle and last parts fog
and rain
So Ends

Sunday Sept 13th 1868

These 24 hours
the same as the last fog
wind and rain from N.E.
So Ends

Monday Sept 14th 1868

Begins with a
strong wind from N.E. with
spralls of rain and fog Sep sail
in sight at 3 PM St Paul
bearing N.E. dist 20 miles
Middle and last parts same
So Ends

Tuesday Sept 15th 1868

Commences with
a strong breeze from E.S.E. with
fog and rain Middle and last
parts same So Ends

Wednesday Sept 16th 1868

These 24 hours the
same as the last wind fog and
rain from E.S.E.
So Ends
