Thursday Sept 17th

Begins Calm
at 1 Pm wind S.W. with fog at
2 Clear ship steering N.E.
at 5 Pm saw St Pauls and ship
sail Middle and last part
fine weather wind S.W.
So Ends

Friday Sept 18th 1868

Commences with
good weather wind S.W. saw
six sail 3 Whaling no one
struck St Pauls and St George
in sight Middle and last
part same
So Ends

Saturday Sept 19th 1868

Clear 24 hours
good weather saw 7 sail
at 8 Pm steered to the
N.E. between St Pauls and
St George So Ends

Sunday Sept 20th 1868

Begins with
good weather at 4 Pm spoke
Bark Gorge steamed to the
S.W. at 7 Pm strong Gale
from N.E. ship hove too
under storm sail
So Ends

Monday Sept 21st 1868

Begins with a
hard Gale from N.E. ship
hading N.W. under storm
sail at 3 Pm hoisted away
the fore spinnaker Gaff at 9 Pm
blowing like mad at
Lat 56.34 1 Pm began to moderate
at 3 set fore top sail at
7 Pm light Gale with rain
So Ends

Tuesday Sept 22nd 1868

Commences with
a light Gale from N.E. with
rain Middle part wind
Lat 56.58 N.W. with hard rain last
Long 172.20 part same
So Ends

Wednesday Sept 23rd 1868

Begins with
wind S.W. quite clear steered
to the East 3 sail in sight
Middle and last part same
So Ends

Thursday Sept 24th 1868

Begins with a
fresh breeze from S.W. at 2 Pm
saw whale to rough to lower
Middle part moderate last
part good weather light breeze
from S. saw one whale
close to the ship lower
no go So Ends
