57 Friday Sept 25<sup>th</sup> 1868  
Commenced with fine weather at 12 M. Saw a Whale  
Landed chased Chases until 4 Pm without  
in sight success Middle and last parts  
Calm so Ends

Saturday Sept 26<sup>th</sup> 1868  
Begins with a light breeze from S. S. W.  
Landed saw a whale lowered so go  
in Middle part Calm last  
Sight part a light breeze from  
S. W. ship heading to the  
S. E. so Ends

57 Sunday Sept 27<sup>th</sup> 1868  
Begins with a fine breeze from S. S. W.  
Saw two Whales one going  
up to the south at  
Landed 1 Pm lowered without  
in success spoke Bark same  
Sight bound to Rhodeak Middle  
and last parts light weather  
wind so Ends

Monday Sept 28<sup>th</sup> 1868  
Begins with a light breeze from S. S. E. at  
1 Pm saw a Whale to land  
in ward Middle and last  
parts good weather at 8 Pm  
saw a Whale lowered the  
boats the WB struck very  
slate and drew all the ends

## Bristol Bay

Tuesday Sept 29<sup>th</sup> 1868  
Begins with wind N. E. at 4 Pm saw  
the same Whale lowered and  
chased without success Middle  
and last parts a Gale with  
rain from N. E.  
so Ends

Wednesday Sept 30<sup>th</sup> 1868  
Commenced with a Gale from N. E. Middle  
and last parts Calm saw  
3 Whales but did not lower  
so Ends

Thursday Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 1868  
Begins with the best of weather saw  
a Whale at 1 Pm lowered  
without success dip sail  
in sight 2 boiling  
Middle part rain last part  
a strong breeze from N. E. at 8 Pm  
saw a Whale lowered 3 boats  
the LB struck but to much  
to hold a tow the boat  
filled with water cut the  
line lost the most of it  
so Ends
