Saw several Whales at 1 P.M.
lowered all four boats the
B.B. got to the Whales and
killed them saw more
Whales so late to try the
Middle and last parts fresh Gale
saw quite a number of Whales
So Ends

Saturday Oct 3^d 1868
Begins with
a fresh Gale from N.W. saw
Whales so rough to lower
last part fine weather and
a good breeze saw nothing
So Ends

Sunday Oct 4th 1868
Begins with a
good breeze from N.W. saw
the land and 4 sail but
no Whales Middle and last
part strong breeze saw
nothing So Ends

Monday Oct 5th 1868
Begins with
a strong breeze from N at
2 P.M. Spike Bark Cured and
got one Bbl Molasses Middle
and last part a strong Gale
So Ends

Bristot Bay

Tuesday Oct 6th 1868
Ther 24 hours
a strong Gale from N.W.
Ship under storm sail
So Ends

Wednesday Oct 7th 1868
Ther 24 hours
the same as the last a strong
Gale from N.W. Ship under
storm sail
So Ends

Thursday Oct 8th 1868
Begins with a
fresh Gale from N.W. at 3 P.M.
more moderate set fore and
Main sails heading to the
N.E. Middle and last parts
a strong wind from S.E.
So Ends

Friday Oct 9th 1868
Commences with
a fresh breeze from S.W. Steered
to the E.N.E. at 4 P.M. gained
with ship Rainbow and
got 2 Bbls Pork and one of
Malasses Middle and last parts
strong breeze from S.E.
at 11 P.M. saw St Paul
bearing S.E. dist 10 miles
So Ends
