Saturday Oct 10th 1868
Begins with a
fresh breeze from S.S.W. ship
heading W by S under double
reefs Ship Rainbow in sight
middle and last parts
a strong Gale
So Ends

Sunday Oct 12th
These 24 hours
a fresh Gale from S.E.
Ship under storm sail
with rain
So Ends

Monday Oct 13th
Begins with
winded S.W. ship heading
S.E. with a heavy sea
and hard rain
So Ends

Tuesday Oct 14th
Begins with
strong winds from E to
S.W. ship are different
tacks at 8 pm wind
N.E. ship steering
S.E. under all sail
middle and last parts
So Ends

In Bristol Bay

Wednesday Oct 14th 1868
Begins with wind
W. ship steering S.E. at 2 pm
fanned with ship Rainbow
and steered S by E at mid-
night ship under top sails and
gill at daylight made all
sail steering S.E. at 4 pm
wind shifted to S.W. and
South at 9 pm saw the
land the two Islands East
of the 72 passage
So Ends

Thursday Oct 15th 1868
Begins with
a light breeze from the South
at 1 pm tacked to the S.W.
at 5 pm strong breeze ship
heading S.W. by S the 2 Islands
bearing S.W. Dis about 10 miles
at 7 pm blowed on to a hard Gale
from about S by W with rain
took in sail and run back to
the N at 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ luffed too to the
East under storm sail blowing
hard last part more moderate
but thick
So Ends

Friday Oct 16th 1868
Begins with a
fresh breeze from S ship
heading to the W.S.W.
at 3 pm wore to the S.E.
fog and rain — — —
