under Stann sail heading
to the N.W.E.
So Ends

Saturday Oct 17th 1868

Begins with
a Gale from N.W. Ship
heading to the N.E. under
Stann sail fog and rain
at 5 Pm wore to the W
more moderate at 6 Pm
made sail and steered
to the South at 7 1/2 Sam
the land steved S.W. at
11 Pm passed through the
72 passage So Ends

Sunday Oct 18th 1868

These 24 hours
begins with a good breeze
from the North ship steering
S. at 4 Pm steered S.E.
Middle part calm last
part wind S.W. and S.E.
Ship heading S.E. and E.S.E.
So Ends

Monday Oct 19th 1868

Begins with
a fresh breeze from S
Ship heading E.S.E. under
all sail hard rain
Middle part light breeze -

The S. Islands.

Last part a strong breeze from
Lat 49.46 N.W. Ship steering S.E.
under all sail
So Ends

Tuesday Oct 20th 1868

Begins with
a fresh breeze from N.W. Ship
steering S.E. under all sail
Middle part calm last part
a fresh breeze from the South
Employed taking up the deck
sheeting at 10 Pm hard rain
So Ends

Wednesday Oct 21st 1868

Begins with a
strong breeze from the S ship
heading S.E. with rain
Lat 45.57 at 5 Pm wind hauled to
Long 164.38 the W. S. S. Ship steering S.E.
by S clear weather Middle
and last part wind the
same So Ends

Thursday Oct 22nd 1868

Begins with a
strong Gale from W.N.W.
Lat 43.15 Ship steering S.E. under
Long 162.48 Breeze ceases Middle and
last part the same
So Ends
