

Remarks On Board Bark Tamerlane

Wednesday Nov 25th 1868

commences with fine weather light breezes from N. E. & backing off an on from N. E. under easy sail middle part the same at 8 pm light and breeze came aboard made all sail steering S. latter part the same so ends this day

Thursday Nov 26th

commences with light breeze from N. E. steering S. E. by S. with all sail set Island of Cuba in sight Diamond Head bearing N. by W. middle part employed drawing anchors and chains latter part light breezes and strange man aboard stowed away in the hold gave his name Lewis B. Johnson so ends this day

Friday Nov 27th

commences with light breezes from the N. W. steering S. E. with all sail set employed getting boats ready for whaling Island of Oahu in sight middle part calm latter part light breeze from the N. employed mending sails so ends this day

Saturday Nov 28th

commences with fine weather light trades from N. E. steering E. S. E. with all sail set employed mending and shifting topsails Oahu in sight middle part calm latter part light breezes employed repairing main topsails so ends this day sail in sight

Lat 12.26 N Long 156.27 W

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Sunday Nov 29th

commences with light breezes from the N. E. steering E. S. E. with all sail set employed wetting hold Island of Oahu in sight middle part light breeze from the N. W. steering S. E. latter part the same so ends this day

Lat 18.57 N Long 156.17 W

Monday Nov 30th

commences with light airs from the N. E. steering S. S. E. with all sail set at 3 o'clock strong breeze sprang up from the E. took in light sails ship heading S. S. E. Oahu in sight middle part the same latter part wind E. N. E. with squalls employed fitting the rigging course S. E. so ends this day

Lat 16.58 N Long 155.37

Tuesday December 1st

commences with strong trades from E. N. E. steering S. E. fore Top Gallant sail and Poy al furled middle part moderate latter part the same all sail set employed repairing rib and fitting rigging so ends this day

Lat 15.20 N Long 155.30 W

Wednesday Dec 2nd

commences with fine weather moderate trades from E. N. E. steering S. E. with all sail set middle part squally with rain took in fore Top Gallant sail latter part cloudy with light rain squalls employed in ship's duty so ends this day
