

Remarks On Board Bark Tamerlane

Sunday Dec 20<sup>th</sup> 1868

commences with fine weather light trades from S. E steering S. S. W with all sail set employed setting hold middle part the same latter part fresh trades so ends this day

Lat 16.27 S Long 156.50

Monday Dec 21<sup>st</sup>

commences with fresh breeze from S. E steering S. S. W with all sail set middle part wind increasing with squalls took in light sail latter part double reefed the Topsails employed in ships duty so ends this day

Lat 18.20 S Long 158.16

Tuesday Dec 22<sup>d</sup>

commences with strong breeze from S. E steering S. S. W under double reef Topsails and courses middle part buffed to the wind at 1 o'clock by the fore yards aback latter part made sail steering S. W at 10 o'clock sighted Hervey's Island so ends this day employed in ships duty

Wednesday Dec 23<sup>d</sup> Lat 18.56 Long 159.34 W

commences with fine weather fresh trades from S. E Hervey's Island in sight ship steering West for Whytootacke Island at 4 o'clock sighted Whytootacke Island bearing W. by N. middle part laying off an on took in light sail latter part Capt ashore two Boats from ship with two Boats from shore employed getting of recruits and wood sundown Capt aboard stood off shore so ends this day

From Honolulu Towards New Bedford

Thursday Dec 24<sup>th</sup> 1868

commences with fine weather moderate trades from S. E laying off and on Whytootacke Island two Boats employed getting off recruits middle part heading off shore latter part getting off more recruits at 6 o'clock all aboard made all sail steering S. W so ends this day

Friday Dec 25<sup>th</sup>

commences with fine weather light breeze from N. E steering S. by W with all sail set middle part Squally with rain latter part heavy Squall from the N. W took in light sail employed in ships duty so ends this day

Saturday Dec 26<sup>th</sup>

commences with Squally and rainy weather baffling winds from the N. steering S. by W middle part the same latter part cloudy with S. E trades employed in ships duty so ends this day

Lat 20.48 Long 160.31

Sunday Dec 27<sup>th</sup>

commences with strong trades from S. E ship heading S. by E under easy sail employed setting hold middle the same steering S. latter part more moderate so ends this day

Lat 22.57 Long 161.07

Monday Dec 28<sup>th</sup>

commences with fresh trades from E. S. E steering S. under easy sail middle part more moderate latter part set light sails employed repairing main Booms and stowing away wood

Lat 25.49 S Long 167.39 W

off Whytootacke Island
