

Remarks On Board Bark Tamerlane

Tuesday Dec 29<sup>th</sup> 1868

commences with fresh breeze from the E<sup>2</sup> steering S. under easy sail middle part the same latter part fine weather ship heading S. S. E. by the wind employed cutting and stowing away wood main Royal yard and sail fiddled sent aloft so ends this day

Wednesday Dec 30<sup>th</sup>

commences with fine weather moderate breeze from the E<sup>2</sup> heading S. S. E. by the wind middle part the same latter part fresh breeze employed. Bounding Bone and stowing it away so ends this day

Lat 30.10. S. Long

Thursday Dec 31<sup>st</sup>

commences with fresh breeze from E<sup>2</sup> with cloudy weather ship heading S. S. E. by the wind middle part the same latter part breeze from the E. N. E. heading S. E. employed repairing Foresail so ends this day

Lat 33.09. Long 161.07

Friday Jan 1<sup>st</sup>

commences with fine weather moderate breeze from the N. E heading E. S. E. with all sail set finished repairing foresail and bent it middle part light breezes latter part wind from the N. employed breaking out between stables to trim ship so ends this day

From Honolulu Towards New Bedford

Saturday Jan 2<sup>d</sup> 1869

commences with fine weather light breeze from the N<sup>2</sup> steering E by S with all sail set middle part wind hauled to the N<sup>2</sup> latter part squally wind from the E with cloudy weather light rain squalls so ends this day

Lat 34.19 S. Long 160

Sunday Jan 3<sup>d</sup>

commences with squally weather wind from the E<sup>2</sup> steering E by S. with all sail set employed cutting Wood middle part wind increasing took in the light sails latter part strong breeze with squalls double reefed the Topsails and furled mainsail and Jib so ends this day

Lat 35.00. S. Long 156.20

Monday Jan 4<sup>th</sup>

commences with a strong breeze from the S. ship heading E. S. E. under double reefed Topsails and foresail middle part the same with squally weather latter part more moderate set Jib and mainsail employed repairing Fore and main spencer fore staysail so ends this day

Lat 35.07 Long 154.55

Tuesday Jan 5<sup>th</sup>

commences with a strong breeze from the S<sup>2</sup> heading E. S. E. with double reef topsails and courses set middle part the same latter part wind S. E heading E. by N. bent the fore spencer so ends this day

Lat 35.08 Long 153.41
