

Remarks On Board Bark Tamarlane

Wednesday Feb 24th 1869

commences with calm foggy weather light
air from the N. Ship heading E. N. E.
with all sail set middle part breeze from
the N. W. steering E. N. E. latter part
thick weather breeze from the N. E. ship
sail in sight so ends this day

Lat 54. 30 Long 60. 32
Thursday Feb 25th

commences with a moderate breeze from
S. E. steering S. E. with all sail set
middle part wind backed to S. W.
latter part calm and breeze from
the W. 3 sail in sight so ends this day

Lat 54. 30 Long 60. 32
Friday Feb 26th

commences with fine weather moderate
breeze from W. steering E. N. E. with all
sail set middle part cloudy one sail
in sight latter part wind S. E. N. W.
steering E. N. E. so ends this day. East
Falkland Island in sight Lat 53. 09 Long 52. 08

Saturday Feb 27th

commences with a moderate breeze from
the W. steering E. N. E. with all sail
set middle part strong breeze from S. W.
sail in sight sails latter part moderate
with cloudy weather wind from the W.
ship heading E. N. W. so ends this day

From Montevideo Towards New Bedford

Sunday Feb 28th 1869

commences with a strong breeze from the
N. E. with thick fog steering E. N. W. under
double reef Topsails and courses middle
part more moderate latter part moderate
thick fog wind S. W. ship heading
E. set topsails and Top G. Sails so ends this
day

At Observer

Monday March 1st

commences with thick fog strong breeze from
the N. E. W. ship heading E. wind increasing
mouth reef the topsails and hauled mainsail and
Dib middle part clear weather moderate Gale
from S. W. latter part the same steering
N. E. W. under double reef topsails and
foresail so ends this day one sail in sight

Lat 42. 03 Long 54. 40

Tuesday Mar 2^d

commences with a strong breeze from
the S. W. steering N. E. W. with double
reef topsails and foresail set middle
part more moderate latter part made
sail sailing so ends this day

Lat 44. 22 Long 55. 16

Wednesday Mar 3^d

commences with a moderate breeze from the
W. ship heading N. E. W. under short
sail middle part the same latter part
wind N. W. heading E. N. E. made all sail
latter part thick fog put the Starboard
Boat out on the run so ends this day
