

Remarks On Board Bark *Turner* home

Friday March 12th 1869

commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W.
steering N.E. & under easy sail middle
part more moderate latter part wind hauled
to N.E. heading N.N.W. employed repairing
mainsail so ends this day one sail in sight

Lat 34.37 Long 51.47

Saturday Mar 13th

commences with a moderate breeze from the
Nth ship on different tack middle part
the same latter part the same strong breeze
from N.E. shortened sail ship under double
reef main topsail and foresail. employed nothing
hold so ends this day Lat 33.56 Long 51.05
one sail in sight and a steamer

Sunday Mar 14th

commences with a strong breeze from the
N.E. with thick rainy weather ship heading
N.N.W. under double reef main topsail
and foresail middle part the same latter
part wind shifted to S.W. with clear
weather heading N.N.W. so ends this day one
sail in sight No Obs

Monday Mar 15th

commences with clear weather light breeze
from the S.W. under double reef topsails
and foresail middle part wind N.E.
latter part heading N.N.W. made all
sail latter part wind increasing double
reef the topsails took in main sail thick
weather with rain so ends this day

From Honolulu Towards New Bedford Cruising

Tuesday March 16th 1869

commences with a strong breeze from
the Nth with thick rainy weather heading
N.N.W. with double reef topsails and
foresail set middle part wind shifted to
S.W. steering N.E. latter part wind
S. steering N.N.E. under easy sail
so ends this day No Obs

Wednesday Mar 17th

commences with cloudy weather light
breeze from the S. steering N.E. under
easy sail middle part rain took in
light sails wind increasing with squalls
double reef the topsails lower part wind N.E.
with thick rainy weather ship heading N.N.E.
so ends this day No Obs

Thursday Mar 18th

commences with thick rainy weather moderate
breeze from the N.E. ship heading N.E.
with double reef topsails and foresail set
middle part calm with thick weather
latter part breeze from the Sth steering N.E.
employed repairing sail so ends this day

Lat 33.56 Long 51.04

Friday Mar 19th

commences with cloudy weather light winds
from the Sth steering N.E. under easy sail
middle part clear weather all sail set
finished repairing sail and bent it latter
part foot rope of mainsail parted so bent it
employed repairing it so ends this day

Lat 32.48 Long 49.57
