

Remarks On Board Bark Tamerlane

Saturday March 20th 1869

commences with a light breeze from the Sth steering N.E. with all sail set middle part light breeze from the S.E. latter part calm finished repairing mainsail and bent it lowered Starboard Boat and got a large bark employed nothing held so ends this day

Lat 32.35 Long 49.47

Sunday Mar 21st

commences with calm weather light air from the S.W. with all sail set middle part wind from the Wth with rain squalls. latter part wind from the S. with rain steering N.E. to ends this day two sail in sight so ends this day

Monday Mar 22nd

commences with a strong breeze from the Sth with squally weather and rain steering N.E. with light sails furled middle part the same latter part wind S.E. with rain double reefed topsails and furled mainsail so ends this day

Lat 29.00

Tuesday Mar 23rd

commences with rainy weather moderate breeze from the S.W. with double reef topsails and courses set middle part wind shifted to S.W. with heavy squalls furled mainsail and did latter part wind from the Sth steering N.E. so ends this day

Lat 22.43 Long 46.15

From Honolulu Towards San Pedro de Macoris

Wednesday March 24th 1869

commences with a strong breeze from the Sth with squally weather steering N.E. with double reef topsails and foresails set middle part the same passed a steamer latter part moderate with fine weather set light sails two sail in sight so ends this day

Lat 26.08 Long 44.40

Thursday Mar 25th

commences with fine weather light breeze from the S.W. steering E by N with all sail set middle part the same latter part wind from the Eth ship heading N.N.E. two sail in sight so ends this day. C. Skinner doing duty as Cook. Maximilian resigned

Lat 13.19

Friday Mar 26th

commences with fine weather light breeze from the Eth ship heading N.N.E. with all sail set middle part tacked ship heading S.E. latter part tacked heading N.N.E. wind increasing took in light sails so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Lat 23.53

Saturday Mar 27th

commences with fine weather fresh breeze from the Eth ship heading on different tack with light sails furled middle part the same latter part moderate breeze fine weather all sail set employed nothing held so ends this day 3 sail in sight

Lat 24.55 Long 42.51
