

Remarks On Board Bark Tamerlane

Monday April 5th 1869

commences with fine weather fresh breeze from the N^W heading on. different tacks middle part the same latter part heading E. N. E. employed rattling lower rigging so ends this day 4 sails in sight

Lat 20. 43 Long 32. 12

Tuesday April 6th

commences with fine weather moderate breeze from the N^W heading E. N. E. with all sail set middle part wind N. E. tacks heading N. N. W. latter part wind N^W heading E. N. E. employed fitting and setting up topmast rigging so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Lat 20. 33 Long 36. 22

Wednesday April 7th

commences with fine weather light baffling winds ship on different tacks middle part calm latter part squally with rain wind N. E. heading N^W with all sail set employed cleaning and painting iron work forward masting. Starboard side lower rigging so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Lat 20. 23 Long 36. 11

Thursday April 8th

commences with fine weather moderate breeze from the N^W heading E. N. E. with all sail set middle part the same latter part heading N. employed cleaning and painting iron work fitting rigging 4 sails in sight

Lat 19. 21 Long 36. 43

From Honolulu Towards New Bedford

Friday April 9th 1869

commences with fine weather moderate breeze from N. E. heading N. N. W. with all sail set saw a school of Blackfish sawed 3 Crabs got 3 middle part employed in minding the Blubber latter part wind from the N^W heading E. N. E. so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Lat 19. 00 Long 38. 00

Saturday April 10th

commences with fine weather light breeze from the N^W heading on different tacks employed Boiling Blackfish Blubber middle part the same latter part finished Boiling employed minding so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Lat 18. 00 Long 38. 00

Sunday April 11th

commences with fine weather moderate breeze from the N^W heading E. N. E. with all sail set middle part the same latter part light breeze so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Lat 18. 00 Long 35. 12

Monday April 12th

commences with fine weather moderate breeze from the N^W heading E. N. E. with all sail set middle part calm employed cleaning and painting iron work outside latter part the same light breeze from the S. W. heading N. E. so ends this day 4 sails in sight
