Tuesday April 13<sup>th</sup>

commences with calm and light airs from the S<sup>th</sup> steering E.N.E with all sail set middle part the same employed sheering and painting iron work fitting rigging latter part the same so ends

This day 4 sails in sight Lat 18.28 Long 35.15

Wednesday April 14<sup>th</sup>

commences with fine weather light breeze from the S.E. steering E.N.E with all sail set middle part same from the E.N.E heading E.N.W. latter part the same employed fitting rigging so ends this day 3 sails in sight Lat 18.23 Long 34.15

Thursday April 15<sup>th</sup>

commences with fine weather fresh breeze from the N<sup>th</sup> heading E.N.E with all sail set middle part the same latter part moderate breeze employed fitting and fanning down the rigging so ends this day 3 sails in sight Lat 16.40 Long 33.38

Friday April 16<sup>th</sup>

commences with fine weather moderate breeze from the N<sup>th</sup> heading E.N.E with all sail set middle part the same latter part light breeze employed fanning down the rigging so ends this day 4 sails in sight Lat 16.18 Long 32.21

# From Honolulu Towards New Bedford

Saturday April 17<sup>th</sup> 1869

commences with fine weather light airs from the N<sup>th</sup> heading E.N.E with all sail set middle part calm speaks English ship Agva. Barker Master 35 days from Liverpool Bound to Sydney latter part light breeze from the S<sup>th</sup> steering N. by E so ends this day employed fitting rigging 5 sails in sight nothing held Lat 15.55 Long 31.28

Sunday April 18<sup>th</sup>

commences with fine weather light breeze from the S<sup>th</sup> steering N. by E with all sail set middle part wind S.E. latter part the same with fine weather so ends this day 4 sails in sight Lat 13.06 Long 31.26

Monday April 19<sup>th</sup>

commences with squally weather with rain wind baffling steering N. by E with all sail set middle part light breeze from the S.E. with rain squalls latter part wind E. to N.E so ends this day 4 sails in sight Lat 13.40 Long 31.47

Tuesday April 20<sup>th</sup>

commences with squally weather with rain baffling winds from E. to N.E middle part fine weather breeze from the S.E. steering E.N.E with all sail set latter part S.E. speaks moderate employed planing the decks and refitting rigging so ends this day 3 sails in sight Lat 11.35 Long 31.41
