

Remarks On Board Bark Tamerlane

Wednesday April 21st 1869

commences with fine weather moderate trades from S.E. with light squalls. Steering N. by E with all sail set. Middle part the same latter part fresh trades. employed in ships duty so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Lat 2. 26 Long 31. 39

Thursday April 22nd

commences with fine weather moderate trades from S.E. steering N. N. E. with all sail set middle part the same with light squalls latter part the same employed planing the decks painting the spars &c so ends this day 4 sails in sight.

Lat 2. 15 N Long 31. 45

Friday April 23rd

commences with fresh trades from the S.E. with rain squalls steering N. N. E. with all sail set middle part the same latter part moderate breeze with fine weather employed in ships duty so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Lat 4. 30 S Long 31. 32

Saturday April 24th

commences with fresh trades from S.E. with rain squalls steering N. E. by N. with all sail set middle part light winds and rain. Sailed of Ferdinand. Nohova in sight. employed washing ship inside latter part the same with fine weather steering N. N. W. so ends this day 3 sails in sight

Sunday April 25th 1869

commences with moderate trades from S. to S.E. with rain squalls. steering N. N. W. with all sail set middle part the same latter part fresh breeze with rain so ends this day 1 sail in sight Lat 2. 10 S Long 31. 10

Monday April 26th

commences with moderate breeze from E. to S.E. with rain squalls steering N. N. W. with all sail set middle part the same employed repairing the stay, washing ship outside latter part the same so ends this day

Lat 00. 50 S Long 34. 19

Tuesday April 27th

commences with moderate breezes from E. the S.E. with rain squalls steering N. N. W. with all sail set finished washing ship outside middle part the same latter part light breeze and rain so ends this day

Lat 00. 11 S Long 34. 59

Wednesday April 28th

commences with rainy weather light breezes from N.E. to S.E. with heavy rain squalls steering N. N. W. with all sail set middle part the same latter part wind baffling with plenty rain so ends this day

Lat 1. 00 N Long 35. 50
