the same latter part under all
sail moderate so ends

S^E by E middle part the same latter part

Commences with a light breeze from the

Middle part steer E^S by E latter part
Wind cuts to N^W strong so ends
Lat 28.01 Lon 36.49

Saturday 3rd

Commences with a strong breeze from
N^W ship steering S^E by E under
all sail middle & latter part the
same so ends Lat 27.06 Lon 34.12

Sunday 4th

Commences with a light breeze from
the N^W ship under all sail
steering S^E by E middle & latter
part wind cuts to the S^W saw one ship
so ends this day Lat 26.26 Lon 31.23

Monday 5th

Commences with a strong breeze from
the S^W ship under all sail steering S^E by E
Middle part squally with rain and
fog topsail and sail latter part the same
so ends

Commences with a light gale from the S^W ship
under double reef topsails & courses steering
S^E by S middle part squally with heavy
rain hand fore & mizen topsail & mainsail
latter part more moderate make sail so ends

Wednesday 7th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S^W
ship under single reef topsails courses & jib
middle part light baffling winds with rain
latter part fine weather so ends

Thursday 8th

Commences with a light breeze from the
Westward ship under all sail steering South
Middle part wind cuts to the Eastward
latter part the same men employed
at ship's duty so ends

Friday 9th

Commences with a light breeze from
the N^E ship under all sail steering
S^E by W middle & latter part the same
so ends this day Lat 20.30 Lon 22.44

Saturday 10th

Commences with a light breeze from the
N^E ship under all sail steering S^E by W
latter part steering S^S W breeze
freshen men employed at ship's
duty so ends Lat 18.29 Lon 23.11

Sunday 11th

Commences with a strong breeze
from the N^E ship under all sail
steering S^S W middle part
the same latter part made the
Land one of the Cape Verde
Islands called the Sal so ends
