

Remarks on board of Ship Tom. Dickason
Monday Nov 12th

Commence with fine pleasant weather & N.E.
Trade winds Ship under all sail steering S by W.
At 3 P.M. make the land of St. Jago &
Navel up south by East middle part the same at
daylight land out of sight so ends this day
Lat 13.04, Lon 22.17

Tuesday 13th
Commences with a fine breeze from the N.E.
Ship under all sail steering S by E middle
part the same latter saw a large shoal
of blackfish lowered for them but
without success so ends

Lat 11.12

Wednesday 14th
Commences with a fine breeze from the
N.E. Ship laying maintopsail to the mast
Boats chasing blackfish at 2 P.M. came
on board without success middle part wind
came to the eastward so ends

Lat 9.06, Lon 20.07

Thursday 15th
Commences with a light breeze from the
East Ship under all sail steering S by E
Middle part thunder & lightning with
rain latter part much the same
So Ends this day No Observation

Friday 16th

Commences with a light breeze from East
Ship under all sail heading S by E middle
part squally latter part calm with
heavy rain so ends

No Observation

Bound on a whaling voyage to the North Pacific
Saturday Nov 17th

Commence with calm weather at 5 P.M. get
a breeze from the eastward with rain
Middle & latter part fine weather quite light
men employed at ships duty so ends
Lat 5.22, Lon 19.21

Sunday 18th

Commences with a fine breeze from the
S.E. Ship under all sail heading S.S.W.
Middle & latter very light air from the
S.E. so ends this day Lat 4.29

Monday 19th

Commences with a light breeze from the
Southward Ship under all heading S.W. by S
Middle part the same latter part saw a
shoal of blackfish lowered two boats
fish going to windward fast got nothing
so ends this day Lat 4.11

Tuesday 20th

Commences with a light breeze from the
S.E. Ship under all sail heading S.W. at
3 P.M. sets in squally with rain ship on
different tack middle & latter part much
the same so ends Lat 3.20, Lon 19.56

Wednesday 21st

Commences with squally weather
wind to the S.E. Ship on the
starboard tack heading S.W. at 8 P.M.
A shoal of blackfish came along side
lowered two boats & got one fish &
carried away the foregallant yard
by the stings latter part squally
so ends

Lat 25.0, Lon 20.22
