Sunday 25th

Commences with a strong breeze from the South ship under all sail on the larboard tack heading S W middle & latter the same so ends

Latt 3.45 Lon 25.14

Monday 26th

Commences with a strong breeze from S by E ship under all sail heading S W at 1 P M raised a shoal of blackfish lowered the boat & caught an middle & latter part weather the same so ends

Tuesday 27th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S E ship under all sail steering S W by S middle & latter part the same men employed rattling the rigging so ends

Wednesday 28th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S E ship under all sail steering S W at 2 P M furled the top gallent sails & fly jib middle part the same latter part quite light so ends

Latt 11.25 Lon 29.13

Thursday 29th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S E ship under all sail steering S W middle part squally latter part fine weather men employed at ships duty so ends

Latt 12.58 Lon 31.32

Friday 30th

Commences with a fine breeze from the S E ship under all sail steering S W by W middle & latter part the same saw one ship this day so ends

Latt 12.36 Lon 32.17

Saturday Dec 1st

Commences with a strong breeze from the S E ship under all sail steering S W middle & latter part the same so ends
