ship under all sail heading S.W. by S
middle & latter part a strong breeze from
the N.E. do ends Lat 30.53 Long 43.13

Monday 10th

Commences with a strong breeze from the
N.E. ship under all sail steering S.W. by S
middle part wind breezes on latter part
squally with rain ship under double reef topsails
wind cutting to the westward do ends

under double reef topsails heading S.W. by S
middle part the same latter part
wind cuts to the south tack ship.
