Thursday Dec 13th

Commences with a fine breeze from the N E ship
under all sail steering S W. by S middle
& latter part much the same. Saw a
number of finbacks. So Ends this day.

Friday 14th

Commences with a strong breeze from the
N E ship under all sail steering S W. by S
Middle part the same latter part light
More employment at ship's duty. So Ends

Lat 38.14 Lon 43.34

Saturday 15th

Commences with a light breeze from the
N E ship under all sail steering S W
Middle part wind came to the westward
Latter part S W. So Ends Lat 39.02

Sunday 16th

Commences with a light breeze from
the S W ship under all sail heading
S. S. E. at 3. A m comes in squalls
At 5 double reef the topsail's tattered part
Mend the mainsail & jib. So ends

Lat 40.14

Monday 17th

Commences with a gale from the S W
Ship under close reef main topsail & jib
At 6 a m came to the southward
& moderate S of force & mizzen
Topsails latter part wind lighter make
All sail one ship in sight. So Ends

Lat 40.10 Lon 46.34

Bound on a whaling voyage to the Pacific ocean
Tuesday 18th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S W ship
On the starboard tack heading S. S. E. at
1 a m the wind came to west middle & latter
part much the same. So Ends

Wednesday 19th

Commences with a light breeze from the S W
Ship under all sail on the starboard
heading N. N. W middle & latter part calm
So Ends this day Lat 41.13 Lon 48.48

Thursday 20th

Commences with calm weather & a heavy
swell from the S W got a breeze at 11 a m
From the N E ship steering N. N. W latter
part the same. So Ends Lat 41.43 Lon 50.21

Friday 21th

Commences with a strong breeze from
N E ship under all sail steering N. S. W
At 7 a m wind came to the S W ship
on the wind with starboard tack heading
S W at 10 A m wind hauled to the S E
Nair ship latter part the same
So Ends Lat 42.04 Lon 52.09

Saturday 22nd

Commences with a light breeze from westward
Ship on the starboard tack heading S. S. W
Middle part wind came to the N W latter
part the same. So ends Lat 43.5 Lon

Sunday 23rd

Commences with a strong breeze
From the North ship under all sail
steering S W. by W middle part light
in North sail at close of topsails
& staysails latter part light
to the S W. So Ends
