

Remarks on board of Ship *Thos. D. [unclear]*

Friday 4th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S.W. ship under all sail heading S.E. by S. Middle part wind cuts to the westward. Ship steering S.E. with four sail in sight bound into the Pacific & so ends this day Lat 55.34 Lon 63.46

Saturday 5th

Commences with a light breeze from West. Ship steering S.W. under all sail middle part the wind cuts to S.W. & flows on strong. Latter part begins to under close reef main topsail & staysails. So ends this day Lat 56.01 Lon 64.36

Sunday 6th

Commences with a gale of wind from S.W. Ship under close reef topsails & courses. On the Starboard tack heading W.N.W. Middle part goes on the opposite tack. Latter part wind cuts to the westward. Ship steering S.W. latter part saw a ship bound to the N.E. So ends. No Observation

Monday 7th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S.W. ship under double reef topsails & courses. On the starboard tack heading south. A bark in sight calls her the Charles & Edward masted & later part much the same ship on opposite tack. So ends

Tuesday 8th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S.W. ship on the starboard tack heading N.W. middle & latter part the same. So ends

Lat 57.20 Lon 65.43

Bound on a whaling voyage to the Pacific Ocean

Wednesday 9th

Commences with a gale from the S.W. ship under close reef topsails & staysails middle part calm. Latter part get a wind from the N.E. ship under all sail steering W.S.W. So ends Lat 57.02 Lon 64.43

Thursday 10th

Commences with a fine breeze from the N.E. ship under all sail steering S.W. by W at 2 P.M. Wind cuts to the S.W. & flows on to a gale. Heave her taut under close reef main topsail & staysails. So ends Lat 57.34 Lon 64.06

Friday 11th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S.W. ship under double reef topsails & courses on the starboard tack heading N.W. at 4 P.M. Tack ship head S.W. latter part wind cuts N.W. ship steering W.S.W. with one ship in sight. So ends. No Observation

Saturday 12th

Commences with a strong breeze from the S.W. ship steering S.W. middle part wind cuts to the westward. Latter part the same. So ends Lat 57.20 Lon 64.32

Sunday 13th

Commences with a strong breeze from the westward ship under all sail heading S.W. middle part wind cuts to the S.W. tack ship head on starboard tack. N.W. So ends

Lat 58.40 Lon 65.28
