Tuesday Feb 12th
Commences with a light breeze from
the N E ship under all sail steering
W. N. W. middle & latter part the same
Men Employed at Ship duty So ends
Lat 13.23

Wednesday 13th
Commences with a light breeze from
the S E ship under all sail steering
W. N. W. middle & latter part the same
Latter part raised a shoal of sperm
whales lower two boats in chase
Starboard Boat struck & drew 20 Ends
This day

Thursday 14th
Commences with the same weather
As before boats still down in chase
At 2 a.m. Starboard Boat struck
& captured one the waist Boat in
striking got capsized & stove same
Got the whale alongside & commenced
getting ready to cut at 7 p.m. began
cutting latter part the same
So Ends Lat 12.23

Friday 15th
Commences with a strong breeze
From the S E ship Clewed down
cutting at 4. At 10 all cut in
Middle part ship on the starboard
Tack heading E. N. E latter part
Opposite tack under easy sail
Boiling So Ends Lat 12.18

Bound On a whaling voyage to the Pacific Ocean.
Saturday 16th
Commences with a fine breeze from the
S E ship on the Starboard tack sailing
Latter part tack ship speak the Bark Aften
Of New Bedford So ends this day
Lat 12.17

Sunday 17th
Commences with a light breeze from the
S E ship under all sail heading E. N. E
In company with Bark Aften at 8 a.m.
Parted company & kept her off W. N. W.
middle & latter part the same
So Ends Lat 11.28

Monday 18th
Commences with a light breeze from the
S E ship under all sail steering W.
N. W. middle & latter part the same So
Ends this day Lat 10.03 Lon 17.16

Tuesday 19th
Commences with a fine breeze from the
S E ship under all sail steering W.
By N. W. men employed at ship's duty
So Ends this day Lat 9.02 Lon 17.45

Wednesday 20th
Commences with a light breeze from the
S E ship under all sail steering W.
By N. W. middle & latter part the
same So Ends this day
Lat 8.03 Lon 17.44
